## INTRODUCTION TO PRB GÜTERSLOH FOOTBALL CLUB

### AIMS OF THE CLUB

To provide children with a safe and fun environment to enjoy a regular weekly football training programme. Provide the opportunity to play football, in the local German league thereby improving Anglo-German relations.

### CLUB ORGANISATION

The club is a self sufficient organisation run by volunteers. We provide football for children aged 5 to 16.

The club currently [2008/2009] has 9 teams

We are members of the Kreis Gütersloh, Westfalen league, [www.flvw-k34.de](http://www.flvw-k34.de) taking part in competitive matches within the local area.

### REGISTRATION

Parents who wish their child to join the club are to speak to the head coach of the appropriate team who will either register them to the appropriate team or put them on a waiting list until a place becomes available. Upon being given a place in the club all parents are required to complete and return the registration forms and any monies before their child takes part in their 3rd training session.

### SPIELERPASS

All players, except G + F2 Jugend, are to provide a copy of their birth certificate and a recent full face passport size photo with their registration forms so that a 'Spielerpass' can be applied for which is a legal requirement for any league fixture. A Spielerpass is a small green card which has the players photo, a unique ID number and DoB details. This is used to ensure that players are playing in the correct team. F1 Jugend players will require a pass to play in the Hallenkreis tournament. Spielerpasses will be applied for by the Registration Secretary.

### CLUB CHARTER

The Charter details how the club is run and what is expected of all its members. Please abide by the Club Charter which is held by team trainers, the Club Chairman & available on the club website.

### SUBSCRIPTIONS

Subscriptions are requested in at the start of the season. The subscriptions are used to help with day-to-day running of the club a statement affairs is available from the Club Treasurer upon request. The current rate for subscription 2009/2010 is: €75 1st Child.

### PARENTAL SUPERVISION

All parents are required to ensure that they or somebody other than the coaching staff supervises their child at training and matches. The coaching staff are unable to administer treatment should an accident happen and are not **legally** able to make a decision without the permission of the parent or a nominated carer.

The coaching staff must be asked if a parent can leave their child at a session and this will only be given if  
(i) another adult agrees to look after the child  
(ii) there are enough coaches present and willing to take responsibility and that the parent or carer is close enough to return to the session quickly in an emergency.

### TRAINING

Each team has at least one training session per week. The training normally takes place on the astro turf at PRB or football pitches during March to October and in the gym at PRB or Mansergh during the winter months, parents are to ensure that children bring sufficient fluids & sufficient inclement weather clothing.

### MATCHES

League matches normally take place on a Saturday kicking off between 9am and 3pm. The team coach will inform parents and players, as soon as possible, of their selection for games giving details of meet times and places. It is normal practice to meet at the PRB gym, approx 1 hour before kick-off and travel in a group to the away matches. For home matches you will be asked to meet at the PRB gym about 30 minutes before kick-off.

It is the club's policy to give all children a chance to play in matches and tournaments, if they want to play, regardless of their experience or ability. The club provides each team with a kit [shirt, shorts and socks]. Players are required to wear their own boots/trainers, shin pads and bring a large water based drink with them.
